Do you like to travel and explore new places? Do maps puzzle you? Or do you want to learn more? Ed Hicks of Orienteering Unlimited will illuminate the fascinating world of cartography. He will explore navigation and map-handling techniques, modern map-making procedures, map history and provide practical information. Ed discovered the sport of Orienteering while attending a conference in 1973. This experience dramatically changed his life. In 1979 he founded Orienteering Unlimited, a company that provides navigation supplies, training programs, and has produced a wide variety of maps. Ed has conducted hundreds of workshops over the years. He bought his first computer in 1979 and initiated computer education in his school. He is a longtime member of WPCUG. Ed is also the North American service and distributor for map-making software.
